

More than 300 youngsters apply for a first ever casting call in Poland targeted to non-binary and trans people. They are auditioning for the role of a trans boy in one of Netflix's feature films. Their biggest dream is to become a movie superstar, but it soon turns out that much more serious challenges await them.

In a mosaic film form, we accompany them in their daily struggle. We Are Perfect is a universal, tender story about people who are tired of being excluded and invisible. It's a story about a new generation of self-aware Poles who refuse to live in a simplistic scheme where there is only what is feminine and masculine.

SHORT DOCUMENTARY 10' BULGARIA 2024

Tbilisi was once hailed as "Paris of the East" for its multiculturalism and eclectic energy. Yet since its founding, Tbilisi Pride has never been a pure joyous celebration of diversity. Repeatedly cancelled by authorities, ambushed, attacked; radical groups, covertly supported by the state and police, have beaten up journalists and participants, and regularly pursue and assault the Pride organisers. Co-founder of Tbilisi Pride Giorgi Tabagari contemplates what it means to be locked between East and West, between home and safety, navigating the perilous path between choosing to remain invisible and choosing to be true to yourself.

Since then she has been the recipient of the Nipkow Emerging Producers Grant, and worked on projects in Moscow, Berlin and Sofia. WE ARE DEYSTVIE

For us at LGBTI Organization Deystvie, the rights of LGBTIQ+ people have always been a priority. In 2016, we were the pioneers in the fight for legislative changes, and since then, we have achieved enormous success for the equality of LGBTIQ+ families in Bulgaria. Part of this progress is:

Recognition of a same-sex marriage concluded between an EU citizen and a third-country citizen for the purposes of free movement, as a result of which Bulgaria granted the right of residence due to a same-sex marriage concluded in France;

The case of Lilly and Dari before the ECtHR – Koilova and Babulkova v. Bulgaria, which obliges Bulgaria to create a legal framework for the recognition of LGBTIQ+ families;

We have litigated and won cases to change the last name to that of the partner;

The Supreme Administrative Court obliged our Consulate in Albania to issue a D Visa for permanent residence to an Albanian citizen who has a civil marriage with a Bulgarian woman:

In 2022 Deystvie won a case before the Grand Chamber of the Court of Justice of the EU - V.M.A. v. Stolichna Obsthina, Rayon Pancharevo (Sofia Municipality, Pancharevo District), Bulgaria, better known as the "Baby Sara" case. The judgment in this case led to a proposal for a Regulation by the European Parliament to harmonise the rules of private international law relating to parentage. Due to Bulgaria's failure to comply with the judgment of the Court of the EU, Deystvie filed a complaint with the European Commission to initiate a sanction procedure against Bulgaria.

With small steps, we broke through the legal barriers in Bulgaria, and by litigating hundreds of cases, we guaranteed the rights of our community.

We thank all the brave people who trusted us in the last 8 years and continue to trust us along the way in advancing policies and legislation in Bulgaria and in defending the rights of all of us.
